Some reasons for allowing teachers, for this year only, to communicate with parents at any mutually agreeable time and not during a specifically scheduled parent-teacher conference time frame.

Many teachers have noted that they have had extensive communication with parents during the remote learning period, above and beyond the norm.

Some teachers have reported concerns about conducting parent-teacher conferences from home in the evening including a lack of confidentiality (others in the home being within earshot) and an inability to secure child care in the evening during this COVID-19 crisis.
