Hello,

To my knowledge the district owns 4 AEDs. The High School has one in the cafe and one in the gym. The middle and elementary schools have one in each cafe. The plan was to buy one more for each school to put in them in the front end of the building more centrally located near the nurses rooms. There was also discussion on purchasing portable units for sports games or field trips. With that being said the high school cafe aed is in need of batteries and pads and the middle school aed is in need of a battery. Both of these units have batteries packs in them now but by the sticker they are expired. There are backorders on these parts that were ordered at the beginning of the year. I have been following up and they do not have an idea of when the parts will become available. The state does have a contract with a couple suppliers to get us better pricing on new AED. I will send that information along so you can see the pricing. Please let me know how you would like to proceed. I do not believe AED exist in anyone's budgets.
