Highlights	<p>*Report Cards: Report cards were issued on Friday, January 28, marking final grades for Q2. We continue to also report out on course competencies and work-study practices in addition to course grades.</p> <p>*COLLEGE BOARD: RHS earned the College Board's AP Computer Science Female Diversity Award for expanding young women's access to AP Computer Science Principles. This year only two New Hampshire high schools received this award. Ms. Swiechowicz has worked hard over the last few years to greatly expand our offering in computer science and it has paid off for the RHS community.</p> <p>*PENGUIN PLUNGE: The Penguin Plunge is on the horizon and I have little doubt that this year will be another record setting year for RHS. Because of the hard work of Mr. Hayes and the dedication of the student body, Raymond High School was selected as a National Banner School as part of the class of 2021. A Special Olympics Unified Champion School has an inclusive school climate and exudes a sense of collaboration, engagement and respect for all members of the student body and staff. Raymond High School was the only high school in the state to receive this honor.</p> <p>Also, ESPN named Raymond High School as one of the top 25 schools in the country as part of its Special Olympics Unified Champion Schools National Recognition Program. This award is given to schools that intentionally promote school inclusion by bringing students with and without disabilities forward and create an accepting school environment.</p> <p>Currently, 117 students and staff are scheduled to take the plunge on Sunday, February 13.</p> <p>*WINTER CARNIVAL: StuCo and their advisors, Ms. Wentworth and Ms. Dussault, did a wonderful job of returning the spirit of the holidays back to RHS.
