Highlights	<p>*Report Cards: Report cards were issued on Wednesday, November 10 to mark final grades for Q1. We continue to also report out on course competencies and work-study practices in addition to course grades.</p> <p>*I Am College Or Career Bound: On Friday, November 12, the RHS School Counseling Department's annual I AM COLLEGE OR CAREER BOUND event was held. All seniors were scheduled to come to the library and meet with our School Counselors or ELO Coordinator to either submit college applications or receive information about apprenticeships, military, or job openings. I AM COLLEGE BOUND is a program sponsored by the New Hampshire Higher Education Assistance Foundation. This year we are modifying the event to include other career pathways!</p> <p>*Red Ribbon Week: Red Ribbon week is a program devoted to the well-being of our children since 1985. The mission of RRW is to support our nation's families and communities in nurturing the full potential of healthy, drug free youth. We have made changes to some of our later events.</p>
Challenges	<p>*Current Staffing: We are slowly adding subs and coverage is getting better, but still a challenge on some days. We welcome Amy Rutledge, who will be working in REAP. We have hired one para through Maxim Health and still need 3 more. We currently have openings for a Case Manager and STEM Interventionist.</p> <p>*Staff Reductions: The reduction of 7 REA positions and additional para positions during the last 7 years has created numerous issues. Additionally, the loss of para positions have further complicated the building safety and our ability to educate our students.</p>
