Highlights	<p>*PSATs: On 10/11, 113 RHS sophomores and juniors took the PSATs.</p> <p>*Job Fair: On 10/25, RHS School Counselors hosted a job fair in the café. 48 students filled out applications for employment with local area businesses.</p> <p>*National Honors Induction Ceremony: The NHS inducted 17 new members into the Twin Oaks Chapter of the NHS on 11/6. This brings our current membership to 37. This group represents 11% of our student body.</p> <p>*RHS Homecoming: I would like to thank Liz Koch and the RHS Student Council for all of their efforts to make homecoming special. Updates	<p>*Schedule: The schedule continues to go well and we believe that it is yielding positive results regarding much of our data (some of it is reflected in this report). We will be reporting out in more detail shortly.</p> <p>*NEASC: Committees have been organized and have been meeting regularly to address various indicators. Shortly, we will be distributing the Endicott Survey to all students and staff. Parents will also be invited to participate in this survey. The survey will help guide our work as we work towards accreditation.</p> <p>*French: French III students will travel to LRES on Nov 17 to teach basic French to kindergartners. We are hoping that this pilot program will be successful and lead to further collaboration between RHS students and the students of LRES.</p>															
Challenges	<p>*2 Lunches vs 3: We purchased additional seating and can provide more if needed. We had to reroute students in the 1st lunch to avoid problems with traffic flow. We are currently working with the RHS Site Council to further improve the traffic flow during lunches.</p> <p>*Enriching Students: We had technical delays which cost us two weeks at the beginning of the school year. Staff had to be trained and allowed time to practice using the new software. Finally, enrichments were added to the rotation.</p> <p>*Construction: The town's waterworks project has been a challenge regarding traffic flow. Despite inconveniences, we have managed to be accident free.</p>
