It was a great opportunity for RHS to meet the 17 8th graders that attended the ceremony. *Unified Snowball: On Saturday, January, 8 Students from Raymond High School attended Unified Snowball at Londonderry. The purpose of the Unified Snowball to bring identified and non-identified together to enjoy a night of festivities. *Winter Concert: RHS Band and Raymond Singers put on a fabulous concert to celebrate the holiday season. Updates	*Graduation: We have just completed polling the RHS staff and parents regarding the moving our graduation ceremony from Friday evening to Saturday. We have also had conversations with the Raymond Police Department and Raymond Recreation Department regarding possible plans for holding Grad Night on a Saturday. *Competency Based Grading: Faculty and Staff have been familiarizing themselves with our 21st Century Learning Expectations. Sandra Gilbert, Liz Koch, and Kim Moyers are the teachers from the high school who are piloting CBE grading on the district's test server. Our CBE Relearning Committee is meeting to formulate a policy regarding competency relearning/recovery. *French: French III students have been traveling regularly to LRES to teach basic French to kindergartners. Thus far, the program is successful and is a meaningful learning experience for kindergartners and high schoolers alike. *NEASC: Committees have been have been meeting regularly to address various indicators and analyzing the data from the Endicott Survey. All committees have scheduled an off site day to work on their reports. *Enriching Students: For the 2nd quarter, there were 4904 relearning/reteaching/extra sessions scheduled for students. We are currently making changes to the software setup so we and accurately track enrichment sessions. These numbers are currently included in the 4904 total.

*PSAT/SAT: All juniors will be taking the SAT on 3/21. Additionally, freshman will be taking the PSAT 8/9 and the sophomores will be taking the PSAT 10 on that day as well. Currently we are looking at organizing a community service day for the seniors on that day as they are the only class that will not be testing.
