> Since our Employee and Student Handbooks were approved, there have been developments in relation to COVID-19 protocols. In order to promote clarity and consistency across our organization, we are proposing to update the language in our handbooks. Our school nurses and human resources professionals worked hard to put together the proposed changes you see below. The intent is to outline the return to school or work procedures while also helping constituents understand what to do or what will happen in the event of a suspected case, a confirmed case, a suspected or confirmed exposure, or travel outside of New England.
