*An amendment to Ed 306.18 (c) has been made that allows districts to set the graduation date at the beginning of the school year and not have to adjust it to accommodate for snow days. The new rule reads: "The high school graduation date shall be set no more than 5 school days or 30 instructional hours before the end of the scheduled school year without consideration of making up lost time pursuant to Ed 306.18 (a)(4)."*

*Given this change, and our Raymond tradition of a Friday evening graduation, I recommend the date of June 12, 2020 for the Raymond High School graduation next spring.*
