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# District-Wide Perspective

- Pre-K thru grade 12 there are 1254 students enrolled in the district
- Currently 288 Identified Students District-Wide (23%)
- State Average 16%

# District-Wide Perspective

- Current Out Of District Placements 13 Students
  - ES 2
  - MS 3
  - HS 8
    - 3 of the 13 were unexpected move-ins
- Current Para-educator situation
  - 14 Significant move-ins since the beginning of the school year

# District-Wide Perspective

- Contracted Services
  - Boothby – Speech & Occupational Therapy
  - Joan Soucy – Physical Therapy
  - Jenifer Morris – Deaf/Hard of Hearing
  - William White Services – Autism/Behavioral Support
  - YEES - Home to school liason

# District-Wide Perspective

- Caseloads – Based upon Programs/Initiatives
  - Connections – 6-10 Students
  - The Learning Centers – 16-26 Students
  - REAP – 12 Students

# Lamprey River Elementary School

- Pre-K thru Grade 4
  - 498 students enrolled
    - 123 Identified Students (25%)
- 44 students (36%) are Identified with a Developmental Delay
- LRES has a fully functioning MTSS (Multi Tiered Support System) prior to referral
- Planning has started to look at the special education programming for 19-20

# Iber Holmes Gove Middle School

- Grades 5 thru 8
  - 386 students enrolled
    - 100 Identified Students (26%)
- 43 students (43%) are Identified with a Specific Learning Disability
- IHGMS – MTSS and Specialized Instruction
- Planning has started to look at the special education programming for 19-20

# Raymond High School

- Grades 9 thru 12
  - 370 students enrolled
    - 65 Identified Students (18%)
- 20 students (31%) are Identified with a Specific Learning Disability
- RHS – Specialized Instruction
- Planning has started to look at the special education programming for 19-20
