Have teachers focus on the students ability to learn rather than just assigning and entire chapter in one week with a google form attached at the end. I personally, and many others whom I am in contact with are drowning with work. I also do not feel the attendance method accurately shows the students attendance. Marking a kid absent within the first 5 minutes of the class is ridiculous when you don't even do a google meet half of the time nor do you contact your teacher. Please factor in the fact that students are teenagers who are required to sleep roughly 7-8 hours a night. Probably more. This is nearly impossible when some students work until 9pm-10pm, get home, and have to work on an assignment that was assigned to be completed in a 60 minute block. Please fix attendance. Please correct the workload. Please create more opportunities to meet with your teachers. Please offer a more flexible remote that benefits people who may be sick. Please talk to your staff and focus on the needs of the children more.
- 21. That snow day was confusing. I wish there was something for us, seniors, to look forward to.

Personally I think teachers should be given a similar survey, asking about their students, if they think they are giving enough work, or too little. And if they think their students are having an easy time with remote, etc. Having a strong relationship with your students, and getting feedback on what is happening and if they are giving too much is vital in a virtual learning experience. Mr. lacasse is doing an amazing job with this, he is understanding that we have other things happening, and we can only do so much, while also making sure we get it done. For me, I understand it is not easy for a teacher either, just staring at little pictures and none of us talking back. Moral of the story, we should establish a middle ground of how much work the students can handle, and how much the teachers should give.
