

# Getting Chromebooks in the hands of students



## Current status of Chromebooks

All Fully Remote students have devices

- All 6 12 grades have devices devices
- Grade 5 is in process of receiving devices this week
- K 4 We are assessing the needs of the students and plan to give a device to every (in need) K-4 student over the course of the next two weeks. A priority will be given to all students that are in need of a device.
- We have onboarded 293 used Chromebooks from the Concord School District.
- We have 600 new Chromebooks on order from HP. 300 of the 600 are scheduled to arrive November 6<sup>th</sup> (This date has been pushed 4 times)
- We will have a life cycle breakdown of all devices after the (November 6th) delivery
