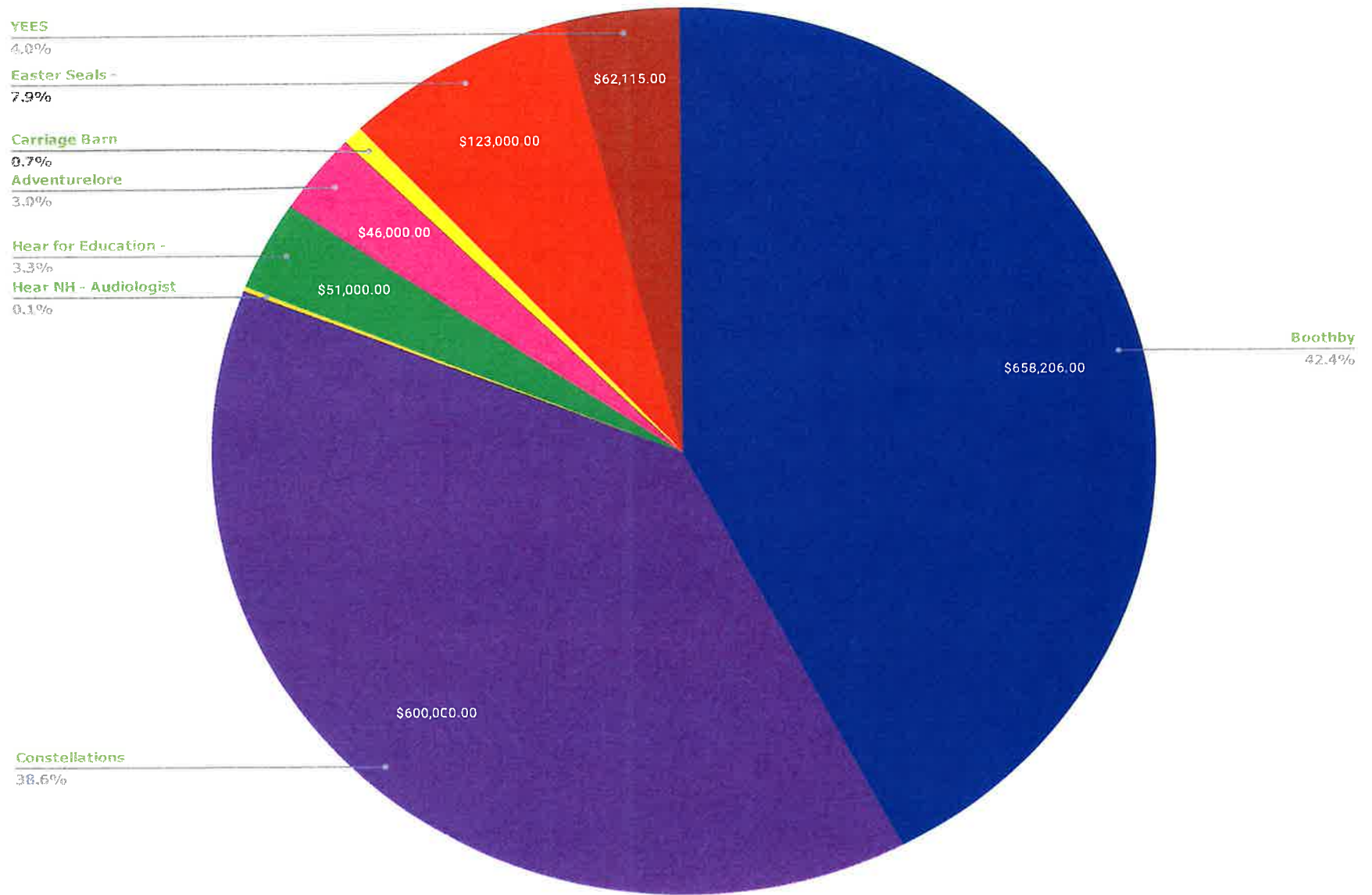
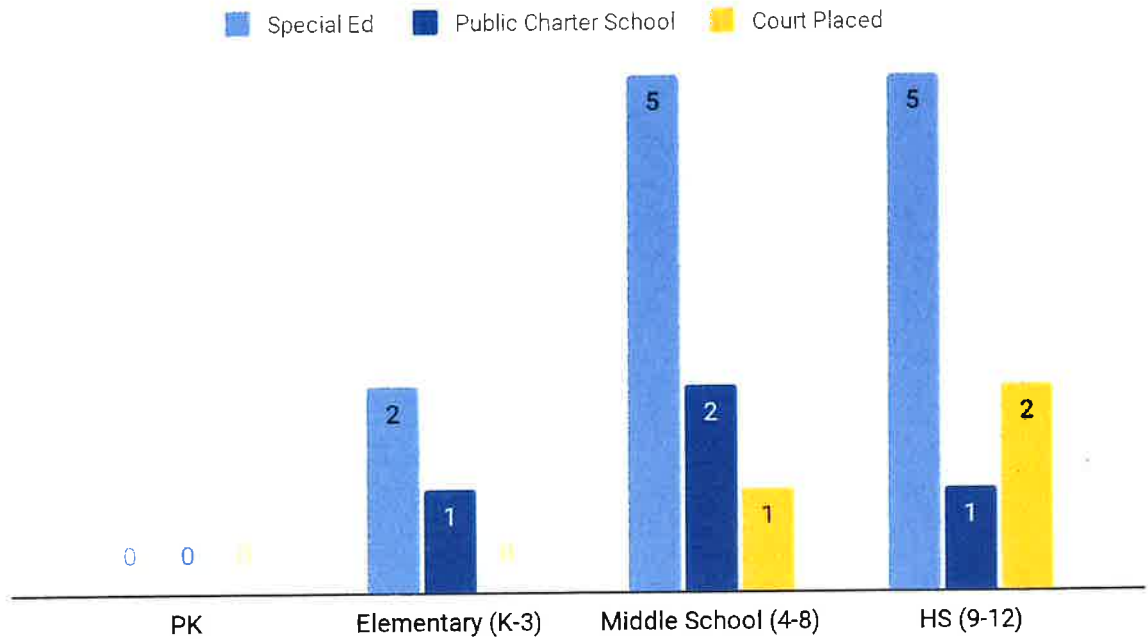


Contracted Services 2021-2022

Contracted Service Provider	% increase	Rationale
Bill White/Constellations	79%	-Building Capacity -5-year plan to fade out -Providing individual service, staff training and consultation to staff -Increase in trauma related issues and behavioral/mental health has impact on the services we provide.
Psychological Services	319%	-SERESC contract; 3 days per week of service for school year; conducts initial and 3-year re-evaluations;
Adventurelure	16%	-Continuation of service for our students currently in REAP. Increase is for additional individual services for elementary and middle school students. - Increase in trauma related issues and behavioral/mental health has impact on the services we provide.
Boothby Services	15%	-increase is service to meet student need. The number of students requiring special and related services is increasing. At the same time, the intensity of student need is greater especially in PK -Grade 5.
Transitional Services	41%	-Easter Seals for transitional services; Also contract for student to attend Project Search.
Hear NH Audiologist	100%	-Works alongside Hear for Education ensuring the hearing equipment is monitored and that it matches student need.
Hear for Education	100%	-Teacher of the Hearing Impaired for those students PK-12 who require this service. -Increase in the number of students requiring this service.
Carriage Barn	100%	-Therapy: Horse riding – Driven Service by IEPs
